



Workgroup Photo Album Project Phase II

Small Group Discussion

Instructions: We would like you to take a closer look at the photographs you have taken during the past several weeks. In your small groups, please share and discuss your photographs. The following questions may be helpful in guiding your discussions.

1. Share your photographs with each other. Start by each individual choosing one photograph to share and discuss in turn. As time allows, continue until you have all shared all of your photographs within your small group.

For each photograph, consider the following sequence of questions:

- ❖ What is it/what do you see in the picture?
 - ❖ How does this relate to your life?
 - ❖ How does this relate to our workgroup?
 - ❖ Why does this problem, concern or strength exist?
 - ❖ What can we do about it?
2. Discuss the process of taking the photographs.
 - ❖ What did you look for when you were taking photographs? What did you find?
 - ❖ What did you discover through the process of taking these photographs?
 - ❖ What did you notice about your community and the influence of tobacco?
 3. As a group, select 2-3 photographs that you would like to share with the whole group.
 4. Choose a group spokesperson to share and describe the selected photos with the large group.
 5. Reconvene in large group.
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
